Getting Real with Marla

The wind gusts of up to 40 mph and wind chill factor of 6 F we experienced January 2nd chilled me to the bone. The really bad news is that I was in my house for the majority of the day! I did bundle up to go outside for evening chores and in my insulated coveralls, I didn't feel too miserable. Please note the key word, insulated. That got me thinking about how, with the proper insulation, we can stay much more comfortable than the outdoor air temperature indicates.

It is time to put my money where my mouth is. I was reaffirmed in our decision to hire a skilled and experienced weatherization contractor for improvements to our house this month. My husband's driving motivation is to save money on the energy bills. The kids and I do not want to have sore jaws from clenching our chattering teeth. I am all for dressing for the weather, but there are limits to cooking while wearing a fur-lined parka! I also do not enjoy the dash from the bathroom to the bed. Our bedroom, located on the north side of the house and over an un-insulated crawl space, is usually eight to 10 degrees cooler than what the thermostat registers.

I have researched and studied

weatherization but do not feel my husband and I have the tools, skills and time to do the work ourselves. In my assessment of the house, I thought the thermostat might be located in the wrong place. A building addition to the home has made the thermostat no longer centrally located. The attic of our home is sadly under-insulated. (see photo) Did you know that up to 80% of a home's heat gain/loss is through the attic? We have 12 recessed can lights that we use CFL bulbs in; but I know they require special insulation techniques. If they are not IC rated fixtures, they could be a fire hazard if they come in contact with the insulation. Duct work runs under the house through the uninsulated crawl space, cooling the air that we are paying to heat as it travels through the ducts and the list goes on. Does your home have any of these issues?

The work is scheduled to begin next week. I hope to document the work with photos and have an update for the next Real Life/Real Power article. In case you are curious, no, Shelby Electric Cooperative (SEC) is not paying for this work to our house. I'm a bill-paying member of SEC, just like you are, looking for ways to improve the performance and efficiency of my home. Stay tuned for next month's article, which maybe I'll write from the cozy comfort of my home, after my fingers, toes and nose have warmed up from vesterday's chill.

Commom Caulking Compounds

(source ~ Bob Dickelman)

Caulk Type	Recommended Uses	Cleanup	Shrinkage	Adhesion	Comments
Silicone	Seals most dissimilar building materials such as wood, stone, vinyl, metal flashing and brick	Immediately with dry cloth and mineral spirits or naphtha	Little or none	Good to excellent	Permits joints to stretch or compress. Will stick to painted surfaces, but paint will not adhere to most cured silicones.
Polyurethane, expandable spray foam	Expands when curing. Good for larger cracks. Use in non-friction areas, because foam becomes dry and powdery over time.	Immediately with solvent such as lacquer thinner	None; expands quite a bit	Good to excellent	Quickly expands to fit larger, irregularly shaped gaps. Flexible. Can be applied at variable temperatures. Must be painted for exterior use to protect from ultraviolet radiation.
Water-based spray foam	Around window and door frames in new construction or remodeling projects; smaller cracks	Water	None; expands only 25%	Good to excellent	Takes 24 hours to cure to a soft consistency. Will not overexpand to bend window frames. Must be exposed to air to dry. Not useful for larger gaps, as curing becomes difficult.
Butyl rubber	Seals most dissimilar materials such as glass, metal, plastic, wood and concrete. Seals around windows and flashing; bonds loose shingles	Mineral spirits or naphtha	5%-30%	Good	Lasts 10 or more years. Resilient, but not brittle. Can be painted after one week. Variable shrinkage may require two applications. Does not adhere well to painted surfaces.
Oil or resin-based	Seals exterior seams and joints on almost all building materials	Mineral spirits or naphtha	10%-20%	Good	Low cost. Rope and tube forms available. Oils dry out and cause material to harden and fall out. Low durability; lasts 1-4 years. Poor adhesion to porous surfaces such as masonry. Should be painted. Limited temperature range.


